

Progressions ABAC - Assignment

Examine each of the examples cited in the ABAC Refrain Structure Test.

- 1. Determine which of them employ Progressions.
- 2. Label each Progression you find.
- 3. Of those that do employ Progressions, analyze the function of the A-sections -- do they follow the traditional functions of an AABA structure? They're appearing in a different order; but do they fulfill the same function?

Example of things to think about:

In an ABAC structure which follows a Problem/Examination/Solution progression, where is the ACTION suggested? Is it in the second A, or is it in the C?

In an ABAC structure which follows an Exposition/Development/Resolution progression, is there a section which can be mentally proceeded with "*That's why I say...*" -- and if so, is that the second A, or is it in the C?

Does the B-section provide contrast, even though it might immediately follow only one A?
