## That is:

- a Line 1 triple
- b Line 2 masculine
- a Line 3 triple, rhymes with Line 1
- b Line 4 masculine, rhymes with Line 2
- c Line 5 triple
- b Line 6 masculine, rhymes with Line 2
- c Line 7 triple, rhymes with Line 5
- b Line 8 masculine, rhymes with Line 2
